CAMS is a case management, document management and electronic filing system designed to better serve the administration of justice, litigants, the Bar and the public at large. It automates many of the Court's procedures, provides increased accessibility to the Court and permits lawyers and litigants to initiate an appeal, file materials, pay applicable fees and view case information including the full text of all filed documents electronically.




